Dr. Naik, as a result of his leadership and commitment to several World Community Service Projects in India, was presented the Meritorious Service Award during this year's District Conference. Only 140 awards are given annually world wide. Our Club should be proud of Hasu, who has raised over \$1 million U.S. through Matching Grants Projects. Some of these projects include the Rotary Eye Institute, a MicroCredit project for single women, a Mobile Veterinary Clinic, Medical Clinics and Science Labs at area schools, Reverse Osmosis Plants to purify water and Vaccination programs and distribution of vitamins. A video presentation followed.
