Michael Beale KTJ, Delta Company, The Essex and Kent Scottish Regiment spoke on Operation Jubilee, the raid on Dieppe, France on August 19, 1942. He then showed, thru a power point presentation, the monument that was built to commemorate the sacrifice made by Canadians on that day. The Maple Leaf, on the monument, is angled to catch the sun at precisely 1:00pm on the anniversary date.
