Radin, who is V.P. of the global equity management group at Toronto-based Franklin Templeton Investments Corp., favours companies whose earnings have faltered over a couple of quarters or that are struggling with internal restructuring. Radin looks for companies that have low downside risk, strong balance sheets and high cash levels.
