## 'ORPHANS AND VULNERABLE CHILDREN IN AFRICA

### LAST WEEK'S PROGRAMME

Our speaker, Bill McRae, in his humour, started by saying "I have 25 years of material - I hope you had a good lunch". Bill took us back to when we were five years old and starting to read. 'Back then', he said, 'you did not know it but you were engaged in the most complex human activity possible -reading. You set the tone for the rest of your life'. Many years ago, Bill was engaged in a 9 -year comprehensive look at reading, with a board of 24,000 students, their teachers and their parents, grade 1 for phonics, grade 4 for reading & grade 7 for reading sophistication. He compiled this massive data by category and fed it back to teachers. His findings in the nine years of testing and the subsequent forty years are that these tests measure the parents rather than the child. He emphasized that 'the child is the mirror of the parents'.
