IN-HOUSE CAMPAIGN TO SUPPORT THE CLUB'S FOUNDATION

I am pleased to report a very successful start for raising the first annual \$75,000 for the Club's Foundation Fund to help offset the \$1.5 million dollars that we have committed to John McGivney Children's Centre and Maryvale

18 members are using PAR to support the In-House Campaign. Their monthly contributions range from \$5.00 to \$100.00 for a monthly total of \$644.00. In a year they will have contributed \$7728.00; for an average of \$429.00.

17 members have submitted cheques in lieu of subscribing to PAR. Their contributions range from \$50.00 to \$1000.00 for a total of \$8680.00; for an average of \$511.00.

Thus, in a year 27.5% of our members will have contributed \$16,408.00! These 35 members are, in fact, contributing on average more than the equivalent one Tim Horton's cup of coffee a day! Now if the other 92 members will do likewise we'll have \$60,000!
