### LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Sam Schwartz, developer of the GreenLink plan to connect the 401 highway to the Ambassador Bridge, outlined how the GreenLink plan focuses on getting the highway to fit the City instead of the City having to change itself to fit the highway. GreenLink focuses on (1) natural features people can enjoy, (2) linking, instead of isolating communities and (3) accommodating all modes of transportation, such as walking, biking, roller-blading, etc. Mr. Schwartz estimates that over 700 acres of green space would be created with this plan. The estimated costs for the GreenLink plan are \$1.67billion. The opposing plan, DRIC, is estimated to cost \$1.5billion. GreenLink builds on projects that have been successful in other cities such as Washington, D.C., Seattle, WA and New York's Central Park.
