John Morris Russell, Music Director of the Windsor Symphony Orchestra, spoke to our Club five years ago about his vision for the Orchestra and its future. To-day he revisited his vision and told everyone what had been accomplished in the last five-years: The Windsor Symphony Youth Orchestra, The Junior Strings, The Peanut Butter & Jam concerts for toddlers, the Family Jamboree Series, to name but a few. These programs create relationships from toddlers to season ticket holders, he said.

He told us about the composer Dvorak and the New World Symphony; of how his students went on to teach some of the greatest North American composers of the 20th Century, even though none of the students' works were ever published.

He told us of some of the awards they WSO has received, including a Juno nomination for Peter and the Wolf.

He then spoke very passionately about the downtown Armory as a future concert hall.
