Hector Clouthier, E.D. of the Ontario Horse Racing Industry Assn. holds a professional harness horse driver's license and is an avid marathon runner, having ran 19 marathons in the last 7 years including the Boston Marathon in 2005. He spoke of OHRIA as being the umbrella for the horse racing industry, which generates 60,000 jobs annually and contributes \$1.6 billion to the Ontario economy or \$2.1 billion with horse breeding added.
