Our own Ron Arkell and Karen Durocher gave a power point presentation on their recent trip to Ghana for R.E.L.A.Y. The volunteers do electrical work, painting, plumbing, bring school supplies and improve the physical condition of schools. This trip was for a specific school, but when they finally arrived in the Village, the school was unfinished. They had noticed a Health Clinic, nearby, that was in very bad shape, and decided to take care of the repairs for it. Life expectancy in the small village is 45-50 yrs. The children of Ghana want to learn but it costs about \$200 for tuition and most people do not have the money. Literacy is a problem. It is possible that two of the teachers will be able to come to Canada, and, through the Board of Education will shadow teachers here. Ron Arkell then traveled to Jirapa, far north of Ghana, to work with Godfrey Bachehie. Godfrey mentioned some of the needed items, one of which is a roof for the Library. President Shari gave Godfrey \$100 towards the roof. Peter Hrastovec said he would match the amount of \$100, and so did Evelyn Slobasky, Bill Howitt, Dianne Moore, Don Larkin, Cindy Fuerth, Om Chandna and Rick Caron. Nancy Leavoy made a donation and then Walt Hadden donated back his winnings from the 50/50 raffle.
