## ROTARY WORLD PEACE SUMMIT

On April 25th-27th, 2008, Rotarians and peacemakers from around the world will gather in Windsor, at a Presidential Peace Forum to share, celebrate and create peace initiatives. This North American event is the fourth and final in a series that have taken place this year in Bulgaria, Turkey and Africa.

The festival will be kicked off with Rotary Youth Day, followed by a Community Parade of Nations. Other events include a Peace Concert, a Multicultural Civic Celebration, an Open Air Ceremony with RI President Wilf Wilkinson, and the list goes on.

The cost for adults is US \$175 and US \$100 for youth.
