Our guest speaker, Federica Nazzani, General Manager, Windsor Airport, received the designation of C.A. in 1995 and Chartered Business Valuator in 1997 and has an Honors Bachelor of Arts in Chartered Accountancy Studies and a Masters of Accountancy from the University of Waterloo. Federica told us that Windsor is ideally placed to take advantage of air freight traffic. She did say, however, that it would take a considerable amount of capital investment to take advantage of the opportunities that exist. Climate controlled storage and warehousing structures would be needed as well as adjustments to our cargo apron in order to consolidate air freights services. Windsor, she said, is directly below one of the busiest air corridors in the world. She pointed to our local huge agribusiness and greenhouse facilities as a potential source for an anchor business. She also noted our potential in passenger business which is now being addressed with suitable renovations to the passenger areas. Windsor Airport has been rebranded as Your Quick Gateway or YQG.
