LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Dr. Allen Heimann, of the Windsor, Essex County Health Unit, spoke to us on the H1N1 Flu Virus and regular flu. There were four deaths attributed to it in our area and they were all males in their late 40s. They all had other health concerns. The regular flu season was also short. A shot will lower the severity if you do get the flu.

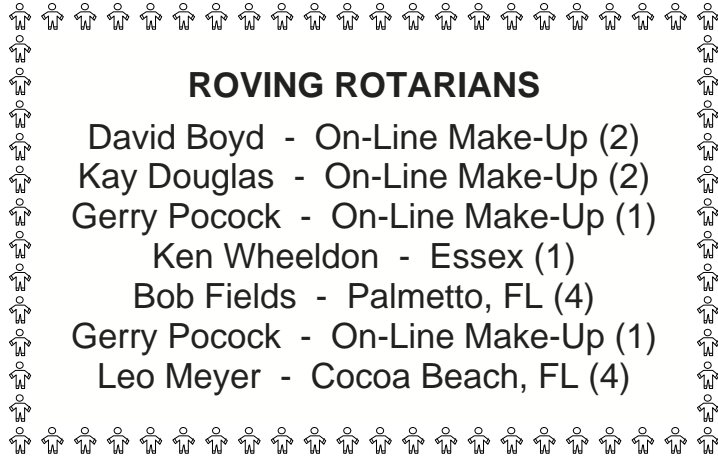
